The reason is that this simple fix will fix any problem in almost all cases. However, if it doesn't fix the problem, you can skip to the next solution. But first, let's see how to reboot the router.You can reboot the Xfinity router using the Xfinity App or you can do it manually.Since the network connection is probably off when the orange light blinks on your router the Xfinity App won't help much.
